- ③ An object that weighs 10 lb on Earth would weigh only 4 lb on Mars. If you weigh 95 lb on Earth, how much would you weigh on Mars?

$$\begin{array}{l} E: 10 \\ M: 4 \end{array} = \frac{95}{x}$$

(Handwritten: $10 \div 2 = 5$, $4 \times 2 = 8$, $5 \times 9 = 45$, $45 \times 2 = 90$)

- ④ The ratio of orange juice to pineapple juice in Tropical Treat punch is 4 to 3. Bill has 64 oz of orange juice. How much pineapple juice does he need?

$$\begin{array}{l} O: 4 \\ P: 3 \end{array} = \frac{64}{x}$$

(Handwritten: $4 \times 16 = 64$, $3 \times 16 = 48$)

- ⑤ A cookie recipe for 60 cookies calls for 4 cups of flour. How much flour is needed to make 90 cookies?

$$\begin{array}{l} C: 60 \\ F: 4 \end{array} = \frac{90}{x}$$

(Handwritten: $60 \div 2 = 30$, $4 \times 2 = 8$, $30 \times 3 = 90$, $8 \times 3 = 24$)

- ⑥ Jose can read 7 pages of his book in 5 minutes. At this rate, how long will it take him to read the entire 175-page book?

$$\begin{array}{l} P: 7 \\ M: 5 \end{array} = \frac{175}{x}$$

(Handwritten: $7 \times 25 = 175$, $5 \times 25 = 125$)

- ⑦ While exercising, Julie found that her heart was beating 12 times every 5 seconds. How many times was it beating per minute (60 seconds)?

$$\begin{array}{l} B: 12 \\ S: 5 \end{array} = \frac{x}{60}$$

(Handwritten: $12 \times 12 = 144$, $5 \times 12 = 60$)

- ⑧ If there are 1,200 calories in 8 oz of hot fudge, how many calories are in 3 oz of hot fudge?

$$\begin{array}{l} C: 1200 \\ O: 8 \end{array} = \frac{x}{3}$$

(Handwritten: $1200 \div 8 = 150$, $150 \times 3 = 450$)

- ⑨ At a certain college, the ratio of men to women is 6 to 5. If there are 1,500 men, how many women are there?

$$\begin{array}{l} M: 6 \\ W: 5 \end{array} = \frac{1500}{x}$$

(Handwritten: $6 \times 250 = 1500$, $5 \times 250 = 1250$)

- ⑩ One of the world's largest stained-glass windows is at Kennedy international Airport in New York. It is a rectangle with a height to length ratio of 2 to 25. If the window is 24 feet high, how long is it?

$$\begin{array}{l} H: 2 \\ L: 25 \end{array} = \frac{24}{x}$$

(Handwritten: $2 \times 12 = 24$, $25 \times 12 = 300$)
